GIMP is a multi-platform photo manipulation tool. GIMP is an acronym for GNU Image Manipulation Program. The GIMP is suitable for a variety of image manipulation tasks, including photo retouching, image composition, and image construction.

GIMP has many capabilities. It can be used as a simple paint program, an expert quality photo retouching program, an online batch processing system, a mass production image renderer, an image format converter, etc. <http://www.gimp.org/tutorials/>

- A full suite of painting tools including brushes, a pencil, an airbrush, cloning, etc.
- Full Alpha channel support for working with transparency (XCF)
- Layers and channels
- Multiple undo/redo (limited only by disk space) - ctrl+Z
- Transformation tools including rotate, scale, shear and flip
- Support for a wide range of file formats, including GIF, JPEG, PNG, XPM, TIFF, TGA, MPEG, PS, PDF, PCX, BMP and many others. Native=XCF export in JPG.
- Selection tools, including rectangle, ellipse, free, fuzzy, bezier and intelligent scissors
